**DON'T KNOW WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR CHILDREN'S OLD BOOKS?
TRADE THEM IN TO RIVERSIDE'S PTO FOR "NEW" USED BOOKS.**



If it feels like your child is asking you to take them to the bookstore or library for a new AR (Accelerated Reader) book every other day, you're not alone. Our AR program is wonderful, but it can be time-consuming and expensive to constantly keep a book in your child's hand.

That's why the Riverside Elementary PTO is introducing a **Book Exchange Program**. This is the perfect chance to empty your bookshelves and pick up new books for your child for FREE!

Here's how it will work: For every 2 books you turn in, you get 1 FREE book in return. We ask that, with the exception of picture books for younger children, all books be on the AR list and be in good condition with all of the pages intact. You can check the list at renlearn.com or ARbookfind.com.

Starting September 2nd, we will collect books every Friday morning in the PTO Room between 7:50 am and 8:20 am. You can send the books in with your children or bring them into PTO yourself.

Our first opportunity for students to turn in their credits for books will be on September 7th or 8th. Students will go to the book exchange at a time selected by their individual teacher. Please be sure to send your child with a copy of his/her receipt that day. Also, please be sure your child knows his or her AR reading level.

If a child loses his or her receipt, please have the teacher send a note to PTO and we will look up the number of books owed in our records. Thank you.

Any books turned in that are not on the AR list, are heavily damaged, or are not age-appropriate for elementary school children will be returned to you and will not receive credit in the Book Exchange program. If you have books you would like to donate to the school that are not on the AR list, please offer them to your teacher's classroom library. Thank you!
